

APPD Learning Technology Task Force, Spring Meeting, 2008

Abhay Dandekar, M.D. (Task Force Chair) opened the meeting, and reminded everyone of the goals of our task force.

Patty Hicks shared a demo of the redesign project of the Share Warehouse.

Discussion was held on how to protect intellectual property, and reviews of Shared Warehouse pieces.

Common program (consumer based) reviews are needed for programs such as: ERAS, Amion, evaluation systems, web based learning platforms, etc.

Each reviewer will need to give specific area or category the review should go to.

It was suggested to have announcement on list serve of new reviews that have been posted with key words.

LT Mentorship/Consultation Example: WEBEx Conferencing to do demonstrations

Reviews:

Currently we have no qualifying review process yet. We need to form groups to review things.

Reviews of two different things.

1. Submitted original products
2. Reviews of technology

Example: System of Assessing procedural competency – original product. This is not scholarship (yet) as we would want peer reviewed.

Can we ask people who download to evaluate it (approx. a month after)?

It was suggested that when you upload, you would have an option to ask for feedback.

It was stated that levels of scholarship to get credit for downloads don't generally matter, reviews are more useful. Also mentioned was the need to be free flowing availability of reviews.

The question was raised "is the opportunity to just share comments or ask questions just to the author"? Patty stated that feedback does go to the author. Currently they have not agreed on the timing of the feedback. It was suggested to have attributed feedback be posted as it is a value to the community (he closed community of the APPD).

Currently the LT Resource Center is all volunteer time, with no money dedicated to this. At this point we have no idea how much it is costing. Other questions were raised about how long the documents should remain on the site

Discussion was also held about sub groups to review before things are posted. Abhay stated that we would want us as a group to become super users of this.

Patty promoted the LEARN pilot project that will be reviewed at the 4pm today at the Spring Meeting. This will be addressing curriculum.

Abhay also advocated for chief residents to get involved in our group, since they are more technology savvy.

Abhay and John Mahan brought up the idea of having a LT 101 workshop for new directors at the Fall APPD meeting.
