POSTER SPECIFICATIONS

Posters must be in place by 4:00 p.m. on Saturday, April 17, or at least 30 minutes prior to the viewing start time of 4:30 p.m. In order to set up posters, you will have access to the poster area between 11:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m.

The area for displaying poster materials is 4 feet high by 8 feet wide. The poster boards on which you will be displaying your work require velcro or push pins in order to set up your poster. Please do not exceed the 4 feet by 8 feet space allotted! Individual numbers will be assigned to each poster and that number will be posted on a poster board. **Please mount your poster next to your number.**

You may bring your poster already assembled, or you may bring items to be individually posted. **We will provide push pins for you.**

Here are a few hints for good poster presentations:

- Make your poster simple and eye-catching
- Use simple drawings, diagrams, graphs, and/or photographs
- Graphics should be explicit and brief
- Have clean and attractive layouts
- Use few panels, including an introduction/summary
- Simple use of color can add emphasis effectively. The 6 best color combinations are:
 - Black on white
 - Red on white
 - Green on white
 - Blue on white
 - White on blue
 - White on black
- Use large print and a minimum of text
- Your poster should contain headings that organize and logically display the information
- While we plan to reproduce all abstracts, you may wish to bring handouts for distribution (at least 700 attendees are expected)
- Stay with your poster so attendees may confer with you.

You are responsible for removing your poster immediately following the poster presentation (6:00 p.m. end time). APPD accepts no responsibility for posters left on boards.
