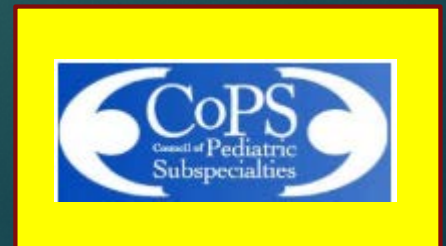

  - ▶ Developing a survey to define resources for trainees and PDs

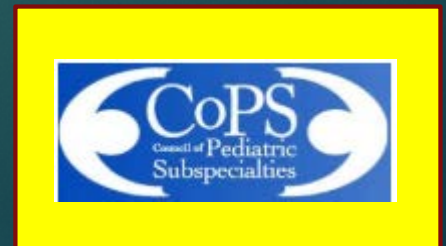
