Validity Evidence for Subspecialty EPAs

- Work funded by ABP Foundation
- Assessing the Association between EPAs,
 Competencies and Milestones in the Pediatric Subspecialties
 - ~205 programs
 - ~1000 fellow assessments by FPD and CCC
- Determining the Minimum Level of Supervision Required for Graduating Fellows
 - Survey of FPDs
 - 82% response rate



Validity Evidence for Subspecialty EPAs

- Longitudinal Evaluation of the Required Level of Supervision for Pediatric Fellows
 - Main objective: obtain validity evidence for the subspecialty-specific and scholarship EPAs level of supervision scales
 - 6 periods of data collection
 - MOC part 4 credit
