

About the Hotel

The Hyatt Regency Hotel is a premier hotel with a resort-like ambience located in the heart of Fairfax County's technology hub at Reston Town Center approximately five miles from Dulles Airport. Reston Town Center offers 40 stores, 12 restaurants, a 13-screen multiplex theater and a seasonal ice rink; located 18 miles west of Washington DC, with access to the Metro subway, Civil War battlefields, Wolf Trap Arena and Nissan Pavilion Amphitheater, plus world-class shopping at Tyson's Corner, and Leesburg Corner Outlet Mall.
