## APPD POSTER SPECIFICATIONS

We plan to have **posters on display at the New Orleans Marriott on Thursday, March 28th between 12:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m.** *The formal Poster Session where presenters should stand with their poster will be held from 5:00-6:00 p.m.* In order to set up posters, you will have access to the poster area between 10:00 a.m. and 12:00 p.m. **Posters must be in place by 12:00 p.m. on Thursday, March 28th.**

**The area for displaying poster materials is 4 feet high by 8 feet wide.** The poster boards on which you will be displaying your work require velcro or push pins in order to set up your poster. Please do not exceed the 4 feet by 8 feet space allotted! Individual numbers will be assigned to each poster (in the Final Program) and numbers will be posted on the poster boards. **Please mount your poster next to your number.**

You may bring your poster already assembled, or you may bring items to be individually posted. **We will provide push pins for you.**

Here are a few hints for good poster presentations:

- Make your poster simple and eye-catching with clean and attractive layouts
- Use simple drawings, diagrams, graphs, and/or photographs
- Graphics should be explicit and brief
- Use few panels, including an introduction/summary
- Simple use of color can add emphasis effectively. The 6 best color combinations are:  

<i>Black on white</i>	<i>Red on white</i>
<i>Green on white</i>	<i>Blue on white</i>
<i>White on blue</i>	<i>White on black</i>
- Use large print and a minimum of text
- Your poster should contain headings that organize and logically display the information
- **If you have additional, online information to share, you may wish to include a QR code on your poster. This will enable attendees to use their mobile devices to scan the QR code to direct them to a webpage with more information about your poster.**

While we plan to reproduce all abstracts in the Final Program and on our website, you may bring handouts for distribution (at least 900 attendees are expected).

Stay with your poster during the 4:45-6:15 p.m. Poster Session so that attendees may confer with you.

**You are responsible for removing your poster** at the end of the Poster Session. APPD accepts no responsibility for posters left on boards after 6:15 p.m.

Remember that all presenters must register for the meeting.
