ABP: Revised Time Limited Eligibility Policy

The ABP has recently changed its policy on *Time Limited Eligibility for Initial Certification Examination*. The revised policy may be found <u>here</u> on the ABP website.

- 1. The policy now allows a period of supervised practice in the environment of the accredited training program under the oversight of the program director and faculty, who possess the ability to assess and verify competence.
- 2. The period of supervised practice has been shortened to a **minimum of 6 months** that may be spread out over a 12 month period. (please note that this period may be longer than 6 months, at the discretion of the Program Director)
- 3. There is greater flexibility in the design of the required clinical experiences, in order to accommodate personal needs.
- 4. Pre-approval of plans for supervised practice and assessment is required for candidates for both the general pediatrics examination and subspecialty examinations.
