Oncology hospital physicians act as front-line clinicians under the guidance of an oncology attending physician. They care for patients with a wide range of disease processes and acuity levels being treated on CHOP's inpatient general oncology and bone marrow transplant units, both part of CHOP's internationally recognized Cancer Center. Our pediatric oncologists and support teams have expertise in diagnosing and treating every type of pediatric cancer.

Oncology hospital physicians with pediatric hematology/oncology fellowship training may also provide coverage for children in our outpatient oncology clinic.
