

The NYU Winthrop Hospital Pediatric Pulmonology Fellowship training program in Mineola, NY is accepting applications for a first year fellow to begin in July of 2019.

The fellows of the Pediatric Pulmonary Division play an integral part in the care of infants and children with pulmonary disorders at NYU Winthrop Hospital. They are involved in the diagnosis and management of children with a vast array of respiratory diseases in the intensive care units, the general pediatrics units, and in our outpatient offices.

The fellows actively participate in the education of the pediatric residents and medical students in both structured didactic sessions as well as informal patient discussions. The Pediatric Pulmonary fellows work closely with the gastroenterologists, neonatologists, allergy/immunologists, surgeons as well as the general pediatricians in a multidisciplinary setting. They are involved in both clinical and bench research during their fellowship training as well as several QI projects.

The fellowship program is a 3-year, ACGME-accredited program. Fellows who complete the program will meet the requirements for board certification in Pediatric Pulmonology through the American Board of Pediatrics. In order to be considered for an interview, please submit the following:

- 3 letters of recommendation\*
- Current and updated CV
- Personal Statement
- Transcript
- USMLE/COMLEX scores
- ECFMG certification (if applicable)
