

We seek all individuals who can bring their diverse experience not only to our institution but to our patients and community. This scholarship opportunity is available for individuals belonging to any group historically underrepresented in medicine including, but not limited to, persons of color, LGBTQI-identified or gender non-conforming individuals and individuals from economically disadvantaged backgrounds.

The Health Equity Visiting Clerkship is a 4-week experience sponsored by the Office of Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion at Loyola University Medical Center (LUMC) for fourth-year students. The goal of the clerkship is to diversify the physician pipeline and advance diversity, inclusion, and health equity.

## Clerkship Experience:

- Opportunity to rotate at one of Illinois' top medical centers in the specialty of their preference
- Opportunity to work alongside residents, fellows and attendings who carry world-class experience
- Exposure to LUMC's rigorous clinical academic environment
- Connection with a faculty mentor who will provide career advice and coaching

## **Clerkship Details:**

- Application: The Scholarship will be accepting applications from March 1, 2022 until April 1, 2022
- Deadline to apply: April 1, 2022
- Rotation Date: May through January
- Award Amount: Accepted applicants will be provided a \$3,000 stipend that students may use at their discretion to cover costs of the rotation

## **Application Process:**

**Step 1:** Submit Scholarship Application to the Office of Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion.

Step 2: Review Process: Once you've submitted your application, you will receive a confirmation email. Applications are reviewed after the application deadline and you will hear about your acceptance within 3-6 weeks.

**Step 3:** Once accepted for this visiting scholarship, the ability to rotate at LUMC will be contingent on the student completing all required paperwork through Visiting Student Learning Opportunities (VSLO).
