- Structure: 70% protected time for research and advanced coursework, 30% clinical time
  - Clinical Duties: Supervising residents in the Primary Care Center and Pediatric Acute Care clinic of the Monroe Carell Jr. Children's Hospital at Vanderbilt. Opportunity to attend in the newborn nursery, if interested.
  - Coursework: Fellows have the opportunity to enroll in either the [Master of Public Health](#) (MPH) or [Master of Science in Clinical Investigation](#) (MSCI) program at Vanderbilt
  - [Research](#):
    - Fellows are expected to design and implement a clinical research project that will result in manuscript(s) for presentation at a national meeting and submission to an academic journal
