### Criteria for Selection of APPD LEAPES Council Members

### 1. Experience

• At least five years of leadership experience in graduate medical education

### 2. Expertise

- o Proven leadership experience in a professional or community setting
- Strong mentoring skills, with a track record of guiding others towards their goals
- Excellent presentation skills, able to develop and communicate complex ideas clearly and effectively

- Enthusiastic about gaining additional leadership experience and tackling new challenges
- Flexible and adaptable, with a willingness to research and learn about new topics
- O Strong organizational and time-management skills to meet deadlines

# 3. Expectations

- O Commit to four years of service on the LEAPES Council.
- O Attend three in-person LEAPES meetings per year, (spring meetings, summer meetings and fall meetings), starting the day before at a working dinner. This is approximately 10 days in addition to the Fall and Spring APPD Meetings. Attendance at main APPD meetings is expected.

[NOTE: Travel reimbursement will be provided to Council according to the following policy: <u>LEAPES Council Travel Policy</u>

- Participate in one hour weekly council planning meetings with the expectation of additional time commitments in the weeks leading up to each in person meeting.
- Review applications for each cohort and evaluate them according to the rubric in the timeline given.
- Review applications for new council member(s) and evaluate them according to the rubric in the timeline given.
- O Join conference calls to discuss applications and advise in selecting applicants for each cohort.
- O Contribute to and review the semi-annual APPD Board report.
- Review subject matter expert content and provide feedback in advance of in person sessions.
- Review online cohort portal content and provide feedback in advance of distribution to cohort.
- O Assess evaluations from cohort and analyze data to report to the APPD Board.
- Create content for presentations and learning activities related to 4 Aims of LEAPES (Leadership, Professional Development, Scholarship, Networking).
- Present your topic content at each meeting: summer, fall, and spring.
- Host intersession meetings throughout the 9 month cohort including journal clubs.
- O Serve as a mentor for a small group project in each cohort including virtual small group meetings scheduled between in person meetings.

- Read and review the assigned book club selection as well as journal club articles in preparation for meetings with the cohort.
- Review and revise LEAPES Mission, Vision, and Aims every 2 years with Council Members.
- O Complete requirements assigned to your role as described in the LEAPES Council Guidebook. (Chair, Member-at-Large, etc.).
- O Address any issues or tend to other responsibilities as needed.

## 4. Council Term

- Council members serve a 4-year term with the following structure:
  - i. Year 1 Incoming Council Member (Member-At-Large)
  - ii. Year 2 Chair-Elect
  - iii. Year 3 Chair
  - iv. Year 4 Past Chair

# 5. **Application Requirements**

- O Personal statement expressing your interest in becoming an APPD LEAPES Council Member, articulating your commitment to graduate medical education through detailed reflections on your experience, a broad understanding of the role's responsibilities and challenges, and your unique areas of expertise, special interests, or training that will contribute to the council's mission.
- One (1) letter of recommendation from superiors or colleagues who have current and direct knowledge of your expertise in graduate medical education, including your presentation, mentorship, flexibility and collaboration skills.
- o Curriculum vitae
- Sample of a recent presentation with evaluations (if available) specifically from workshops, seminars or other small group teaching experiences, preferably from regional or national level presentations
- Interview and 15-minute presentation on a topic of your choice

### **Special Considerations**

O As we recruit additional APPD LEAPES Council members, we are committed to fostering and enhancing equity, diversity and inclusion within the Council.

## **Application Process:**

- Applicants submit application materials via online submission site by January 30, 2026
- LEAPES Council will interview candidates
- During the interview, candidates will give a 15 minute presentation on a topic of their choice with slides
- LEAPES Chair notifies applicants by February 27, 2026
