



Scholarship for Residency and Fellowship Program Coordinators/Educational Specialists

Instructions and Criteria

A meeting registration scholarship will be awarded to assist Pediatric Program Coordinators/Educational Specialists who wish to attend the APPD Fall or Spring Meeting.

Please read the instructions carefully before completing the application.

1. To be considered for this scholarship, the following criteria must be met:
 - a. Applicants must have an active membership with the APPD;
 - b. Applicants should have not been awarded an APPD scholarship within the last 5 years;
2. Applicants must submit a Letter of Endorsement from Program Director and/or Department Chair.
3. If you meet the above criteria, applications will be subject to the following considerations in order and/or on a case-by case basis:
 - a. Applicant has never attended an APPD Spring or Fall Meeting;
 - b. Length of time in your current position has been two (2) years, or more;
 - c. Program is already paying for another coordinator from the same program to attend the meeting;
 - d. Scholarship applicants whose primary job function is to oversee coordinators of numerous programs or work in the GME office, will be considered for scholarships only after eligible program-specific coordinator applicants have been awarded the scholarships.
4. Applications must be submitted by January 5, 2026 for the APPD Spring Meeting. Applications received after the deadline submission will not be considered.
5. All applications will be reviewed by the Scholarship Committee. Scholarship recipients will be notified by e-mail by January 16, 2026 for the APPD Spring Meeting.
